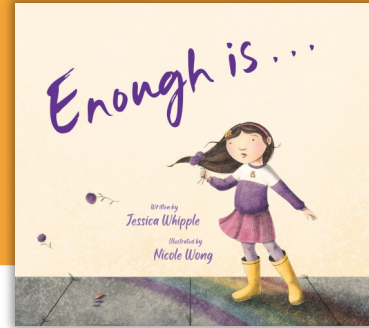

### Presentations for an Elementary Audience

**“The People Who Make Books”** - Age-appropriate presentation about the publishing industry and/or the writing process. Includes read-aloud (ENOUGH IS... or I THINK I THINK A LOT), Q&A, book signing. 45-60 minutes

**“Wants, Needs, and Enough”** - Based on ENOUGH IS... Includes read-aloud (ENOUGH IS...) Q&A, book signing. An excellent supplement to wants/needs curriculum. 45-60 minutes

### Presentations for a High School Audience

**“The Poetry of Picture Books”** - Discusses the picture book form and its similarities to poetry. Includes icebreaker, examples, Q&A. Works for creative writing or English classes, a small group of strong student writers, or literary magazine staff. 35-45 minutes

**“Picturebooking as a Career”** - Explores writing, querying, submissions, and traditional publication from Jessica’s experience. Suitable as a career talk or a dip into the “how” of publishing picture books.
